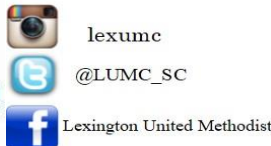

But thanks be to God, our Christian faith brings us a brand-new year through giving us the season of Advent - a season full of renewed hope, peace, joy, and love! Throughout the Sundays of Advent, in the midst of beautiful and symbolic decorations we've come to know and love at LUMC this time of year, we will remember, reflect on, and renew the promises of our faith in which God calls us to believe, despite whatever chaos is going on in the world around us! Make Christmas Merry! Snack Sack

School is now in full swing and we are feeding 500+ students again this year. Harvest Hope has delivered our inventory of food for November. The food comes prepackaged when delivered. This speeds up and limits the handling of food items. But this change also brings an increased cost! We now pay \$6 per student per week for the Harvest Hope food. We expect 32 weeks of feeding, starting with 500 students for an approximate cost of \$96,000. These numbers will change based on student counts. We thank you for your continued support of our Snack Sack Ministry.
