NEW EPIPHANY WORSHIP SERIES!

"Epiphany" means... "a sudden or great revealing or manifestation". It is celebrated in the Western Christian Church on January 6th, and lasts until the last Sunday before Ash Wednesday. Epiphany represents the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles, and the main theme of Epiphany is - Jesus as the light of the world, revealed to all nations, including the Gentiles. The number of Sundays in the Epiphany season differs every year, depending upon when Easter falls. But Epiphany always begins with the Baptism of Jesus Sunday and ends with Transfiguration Sunday. As we gather for worship at LUMC each Sunday of the Epiphany season, we will be highlighting the theme of: "darkness into light". "Secondary" worship themes throughout the month of January will include Human Relations Day on January 17th and Ecumenical Sunday on January 24th. Please join us either in person or virtual for our Traditional (9am) or Contemporary (11am) worship services each week as we celebrate the true Light in our lives.

Snack Sack

School is now in full swing and we are feeding 500+ students again this year. Harvest Hope has delivered our inventory of food for January. The food comes prepackaged when delivered. This speeds up and limits the handling of food items. But this change also brings an increased cost! We now pay \$6 per student per week for the Harvest Hope food. We expect 32 weeks of feeding, starting with 500 students for an approximate cost of \$96,000. These numbers will change based on student counts. We thank you for your continued support of our Snack Sack Ministry.
