SNACK SACK

At the end of this month, all Snack Sack invoices will be paid. But, we will still need to raise additional funds to cover the purchase of food for April and May. In January, we restarted our High School program feeding students through the Athletic Departments of both Pelion and White Knoll High Schools. Currently, we're feeding 1500 to 2000 students per week with in-person learning.

The Blessing Boxes have been subsidized by the Snack Sack Funds during Covid-19. We spend approximately \$100.00 per box per week to load the boxes twice each week. **WE NOW NEED TO LOAD BOTH BOXES THREE TIMES EACH WEEK TO MATCH THE NEEDS.**
