### **New and Revised Covid-19 Guidelines**

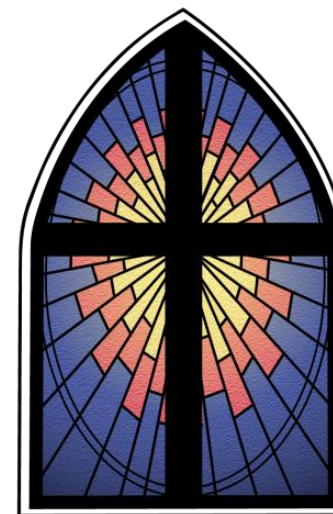
