Description of duties

- Perform minor to mid-level repairs to systems, calling in outside support when necessary.
- Coordinate the tasks of the third-party network administration vendor.
- Oversee the purchase of software and hardware for church use.
- Provide training as needed to pastors and staff to ensure computers are used to full potential.
- Arrange professional training for staff when needed.
- Make users aware of software license restrictions and copyright restrictions.

Budget Responsibilities

Prepare an annual budget that allows for regular maintenance of all components of the network as well as hardware and software upgrades.

Time requirements

If there is an active issue or upgrade with computers, there may be several hours per week involved; otherwise, the administrator should expect to devote one to two hours per week on routine tasks.
