Description of Duties

- Plan and implement opportunities for members of the congregation and community to experience the labyrinth walk.
- Set up and take down for labyrinth events.
- Store and maintain the labyrinth.
- Include members of the community at large for certain labyrinth events.

Team member duties:

- Walk the labyrinth regularly as part of your personal spiritual growth.
- Attend and contribute at the team meetings.
- Assist in setting up and taking down equipment for labyrinth walks.
- Other duties as assigned by the Team Leader.

Budget Responsibilities

Contribute to the preparation of the annual budget as needed.

Annual Charge Conference Attendance

The annual Charge Conference meeting is an important connectional meeting between our church and the conference. As a team member you are not required but are strongly encouraged to attend for information and to increase your understanding of the United Methodist Church.

Time Requirements

- Meetings are held annually or as needed and last approximately one hour.
- Assemble, disassemble, store, and maintain the labyrinth for approximately 30 minutes for set up and 30 minutes for take down each time you perform this service.
- Be present as needed on a rotating basis throughout the labyrinth event.

Term

One year, renewable if agreed to by the team member.

Training and resources

The labyrinth Team Member should approach this ministry with a willingness to serve. The team leader and/or the team member will provide individual training on assembling, disassembling, storing, and caring for the labyrinth. Following that, you will participate in at least one labyrinth walk event. This should prepare you for the times that you will take the lead role for a labyrinth event. In addition, you are encouraged to visit other churches to observe ways to improve the labyrinth walk at our church.
