CAN YOU GIVE?

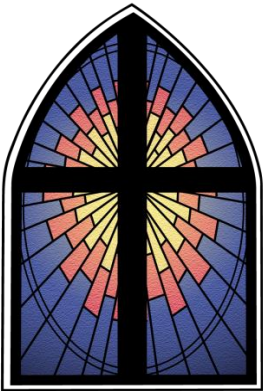
