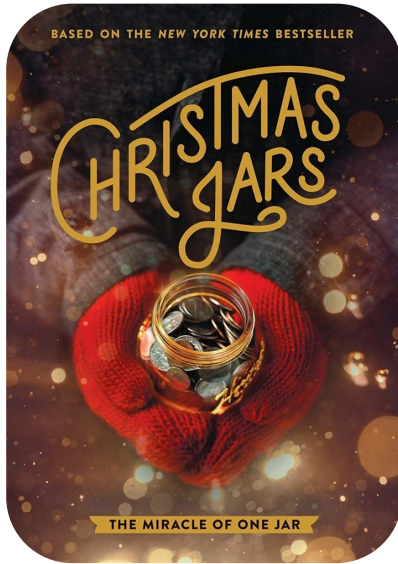


We need your help to furnish food for the LUMC Blessing Box. The Box is empty or has a very limited food supply most days.

This is a reminder that you should be filling your jar with coins and bills so you can give it away.

All coins are donated to the jar all year long. During the week before Christmas you carefully select someone to give it to **anonymously**.

**Remember, you are giving the jar away—don't bring it to church—give the gift away from your heart!**

**Didn't get to pick up a jar earlier? You can still participate. Find an old, empty jar at home. Start now filling the jar with all of your spare change. And the week before Christmas, find that person who is out of work; a coworker struggling with health problems; a friend lost a loved one and needs help; a family who needs extra help for a good Christmas meal.**

**Simply put your jar on their porch, in their car, on their desk — wherever — and you could change their life ... for good!**

**\$50, \$100, even \$200, you'll be surprised how much change you can generate and how much you can impact someone's life.**

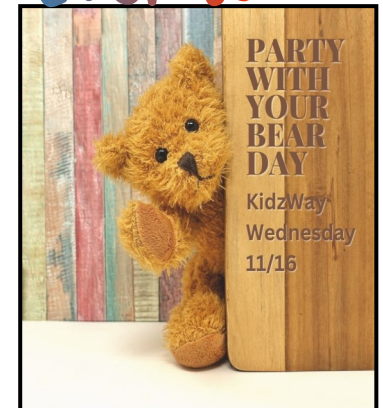

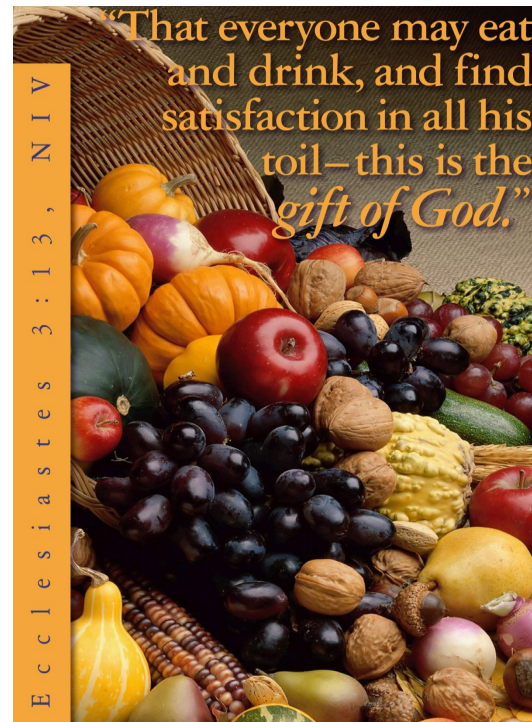
