Purpose

Responsible to

Description of duties

- Organize and lead monthly breakfast meetings.
- Organize fundraisers during the year.
- Become familiar with the rules and regulations governing the Lexington UMM.
- Serve as liaison between the UMM and other church groups for volunteer and financial needs.
- Become familiar with the Vision and Mission statements of the church. Plan the goals and activities of the UMM to fulfill these statements.
- Recruit men to become a part of the UMM fellowship

Budget Responsibilities

- Meet with UMM Treasurer for monthly report.
- Provide requested budget information to Finance Chair for the annual budget.

Annual Charge Conference Attendance

The annual Charge Conference meeting is an important connectional meeting between our church and the conference. You should make every effort to attend this meeting. If your position requires that you report to the Charge Conference, make preparations for this report well ahead of the meeting date.

Time requirements

- Attend called meetings of the Church Council.
- Attend monthly meetings of the United Methodist Men.
- 3-5 hours per month.

Term

One year, with annual renewal (if mutually desired) for a maximum of 3 years.
