Responsible to

Lexington UMW Board, District Unit President and Conference Level, Contact person for District Unit President and Conference.

Description of duties

- Serve as chairperson of LUMW Executive Board.
 - o Set positive tone for teamwork.
 - o Assist board members in setting advocacy and fundraising goals for mission (local, District, Conference).
 - o Encourage officers to learn more about work of UMW and how each office supports the whole organization.
 - o Work with Executive Board to develop the local unit as a Mission Today Unit.
 - o Assist Board in planning local Unit meetings, mission fundraisers.
 - o Assist/encourage each Board member in fulfilling her designated responsibilities.
- Communicate with all members the goals, decisions, programs, needs, etc. of the local Unit.
- Lead local Unit meetings.
- Encourage members to participate in District and Conference opportunities.
- Read and promote RESPONSE magazine and PRAYER CALENDAR.
- Address concerns/needs of Executive Board and other UMW members.
- Serve as contact for District Unit President and Conference organizations.

Budget Responsibilities

Oversee the annual budget. Give guidance and suggestions in setting the annual UMW budget. Follow up with UMW treasurer to make sure commitments to district and conference are paid on time.

Annual Charge Conference Attendance

The annual Charge Conference meeting is an important connectional meeting between our church and the conference. You should make every effort to attend this meeting. If your position requires that you report to the Charge Conference, make preparations for this report well ahead of the meeting date.

Time requirements

- Attend Board meetings as scheduled.
- Attend quarterly & preside over Unit meetings.
- Promote and attend District meetings as time permits.
- Attend all UMW Special Events.
- Serve on the Church Council and attend meetings as scheduled (4-5 times a year).
- Provide UMW's active support for needs of minister and/or other church staff and all governing bodies of the congregation.
- Communicate UMW goals, activities, and needs with minister, associate minister, and other Church Staff.
- Provide written reports of all UMW goals and activities to governing boards of the church.

Term

Prefer 3-year commitment.
