




We need your help to furnish food for the LUMC Blessing Box. The Box is empty or has a very limited food supply most days.



Please sign up <u>here</u> to help teach Children's Sunday school. Children sing with Ms. Lessie and then separate into two classrooms.


Safe Sanctuary states there needs to be two adults in the classroom. Won't you be one of those adults?


