# NATIVE AMERICAN ELDER BASKETS

The Outreach Committee is asking for your help in filling boxes for elder Native Americans. The boxes will be placed outside Pastor Mac's Office on Sept. 1. We will collect until Sept. 30. The items in the boxes will be delivered to the Native Americans in October, Many Native Americans suffer from food insecurity (hunger) and lack of healthy food access. With the increase in prices of food and personal care products over the last year the need for help continues. Please consider helping with this situation by placing some of the following items in the boxes. Money may also be donated which will be used to buy Walmart gift cards. These cards will be used by the SCUMC Native American Committee to purchase items needed to complete the baskets. Items needed are: canned meats; canned vegetables; dried beans, rice, and potatoes; canned fruit & fruit cups; boxed mac & cheese; canned or jarred tomato sauce; evaporated or powdered milk; peanut butter; laundry detergent; dish detergent to be used at a sink; bars of bath soap; toothpaste & tooth brushes; shampoo & body lotion; bathroom tissue; paper towels.
