Pastor Meegian and Heather Connor will offer a drive thru imposition of ashes opportunity for anyone unable to attend the evening service.

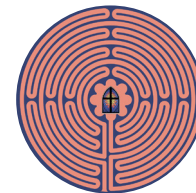

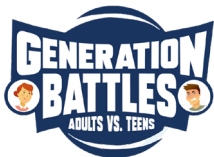

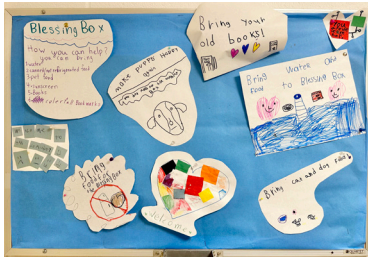
