Therefore, I will not be pursuing Salkehatchie anymore with our LUMC members.

We have a lot of wonderful things continuing to happen at LUMC. Among them, I am looking forward to the Roswell Presbyterian Church 96:ONE Youth Choir giving us a free concert on Friday, June 6 at 7:00 p.m. in our LUMC sanctuary. We also have LUMC representatives attending our Annual Conference in Greenville from June 8-11. I appreciate what you all do in LUMC, as you too labor to spread the life-giving message of the Gospel. May God continue to bless our church and our efforts for Jesus!




