# LOVE'S PURE LIGHT BY THE REV. TIFFANY McDonald

The magi, or wise men, observed a star in the East (Matthew 2:1-12). They interpreted it as a fulfilling of prophecy that the King of the Jews had been born. Unfortunately, they went to King Herod, who became frightened by their belief. Yet, Herod encouraged them to follow the star, so that he might learn of his future rival.

"When they had heard the king, they set out, and there, ahead of them, went the star that they had seen in the east, until it stopped over the place where the child was. When they saw that the star had stopped, they were overwhelmed with joy" (Matthew 2:9-10).

The star stopped over Bethlehem. The magi followed the light and found Jesus. We, too, are called to not only follow the light, but also to shine the light of Christ in the world.

In the northern hemisphere, Advent coincides with shorter days and longer nights. The darkness of the longest night mirrors much of the heaviness we carry. We ask for healing for ourselves, but also for all of those who are hurting in our broken world.

Because God's love for us is unconditional, we do not have to earn it. We open our hearts to divine grace and mercy as we pray Psalm 80:7: "Restore us, O God of hosts; let your face shine, that we may be saved."
