This period holds deep significance as it commemorates the forty days Jesus spent in the wilderness, where he faced temptation and prepared for his ministry. Today, Christians focus on their relationship with God, growing as disciples and extending ourselves, often choosing to give up something or to volunteer and give of ourselves for others.

Registration Fee: \$125 per child payable at online registration and is NON-REFUNDABLE

Tuition Fee: Tuition is per class enrolled and the fee is broken down into 9 monthly payments (September-May). The monthly fee also includes your supply fee. Multi-Child Discount applies if you have more than one child in your family attending the preschool. Your monthly fees for the 2nd and subsequent children will be reduced by \$5.00. There are no discounts on Lunch Bunch or Registration Fees.

LUMC Members: Receive a 10% discount on their monthly fees. No discounts are given on Lunch Bunch or Registration Fees.

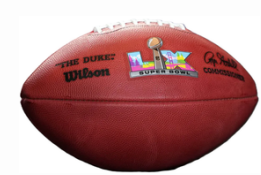
