Weekly Wednesdays – 5pm | Asbury Hall





Outreach-- addressing Food Insecurity



The Lexington UMC Snack Sack program works together to send breakfast and other snacks home for the weekend to over 900 school kids. We would like to think that food insecurity is not an issue in the Lexington area. Looking at all the nice subdivisions in the area, you would believe that to be true. However, serving 900 children tells us something different!

There is a dedicated team of community and church member volunteers who pack bags each week; volunteers who deliver to the different schools; volunteers who break apart and recycle the cardboard; who fill the snack bins so they are ready for the packers; and volunteers who pack the bigger bags and keep count as to how many bags have been packed and are ready to go.

This is not a small operation that can be run by one, two or five people. Each and every person that shows up on Tuesday mornings works steadily until all the bags are packed, bins replenished, cardboard ready to go, and bags in cars to go to the schools.

The food sent home with the students does not come free (with exception of the Ramen noodles, which are donated by a Saluda factory, so thankful for this generous gift). Financial support from LUMC is critical. **YOU** are LUMC. LUMC is not an entity—not “this church”, as I heard repeated over and over again recently. It is the **people** who make up a church and **YOU** are the people who make up LUMC and make it function as “the church” that Wesley envisioned. So, will you step up? **Will you help support this critical mission that began in our church in 2004?**

We are grateful for the community support Snack Sack receives, now, it is time for **you**, the people of LUMC, to step up to meet or exceed the support we receive from the community. **YOU**, the people of LUMC **can** do this. Whatever **YOU** can give will be efficiently put to reducing the food insecurity in our community.


