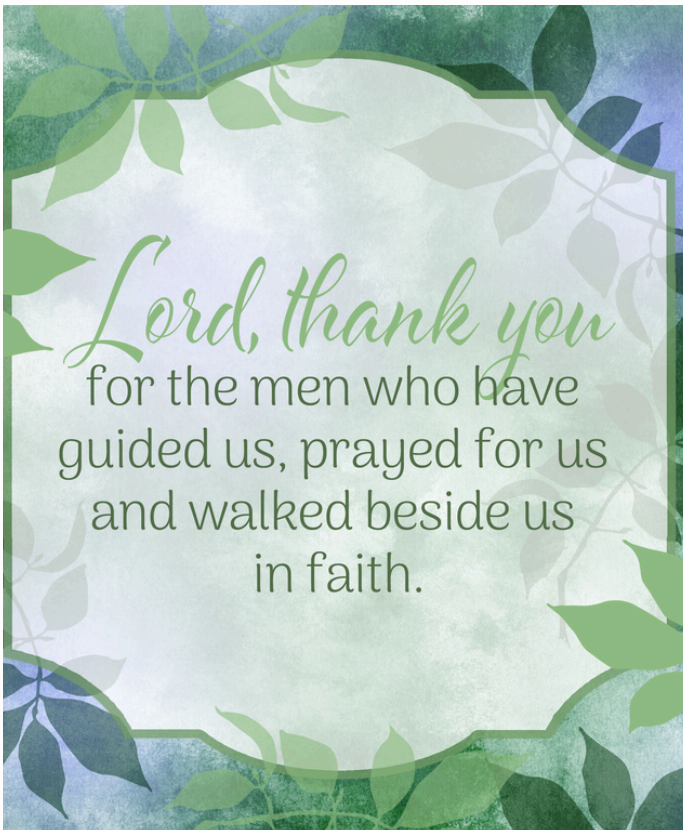

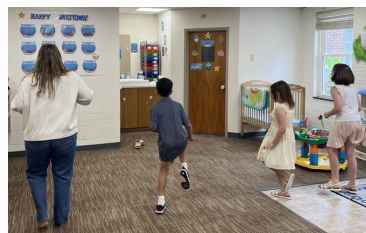
See you in Sunday School this summer!
